I, the undersigned, apply to enter the event described above and in consideration thereof:

- 1. I hereby declare that I have had the opportunity to read and that I understand the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the ACU Standing Regulations as have or may be issued for the event and agree to be bound by them.
- 2. I further declare that I am physically and mentally fit to take part in the event and am competent to do so.
- 3. I confirm that I understand the nature and type of event and the risks inherent with the sport and agree to accept the same notwithstanding that such risks may involve negligence on the part of the organisers/officials.
- 4. I further declare that I shall not seek to claim against the SACU Ltd; the organisers nor their officials; the landowners; the promoter or other bodies or individuals connected with the event in respect of any damage to my property howsoever caused, and whether by the negligence or breach of statutory duty of the said bodies and persons and agree that any injury report will be able to be shared between the medical staff and the club for insurance purposes.
- 5. I further agree that the machine which I enter and compete on shall be suitable and proper for its purpose and that it will comply with the regulations in respect thereof and is described above.
- 6. To comply with GDPR I herewith give GMC Ltd permission to store my information.
- 7. I confirm that I am not currently suspended from SACU/ACU permitted competition or on the ACU/SACU Stop list as a result of incurring a concussion injury. I shall notify the club should I incur such a suspension or concussion injury between now and the race event.

## Acknowledgement of the Risk of Motor Sport

I understand that by taking part in this event I am exposed to a risk of death; becoming permanently disabled or suffering some other serious injury and I acknowledge that even in the event that negligence on the part of SACU; the promoter; the organising club; the venue owner, or any individual carrying out duties on their behalf were to be a contributory cause of any serious injury I may suffer, the dominant cause of any serious injury will always be my voluntary decision to take part in a high risk activity. Jurisdiction: The meeting held under the National Sporting Code, Environmental Code and Motocross Standing Regulations of the ACU, SACU 2022 edition, these Supplementary Regulations, SACU Motocross Regulations and any further instructions or official announcements made.

**Event timings: Friday** Scrutineering /sign on 2pm-5pm; **Saturday** Scrutineering /sign on 8am – 9am, Practice 9-15am; Racing to follow. **Sunday** Scrutineering /sign on 8-30am – 9am, Practice **9-15am-9-30am**; Racing to follow.

Non-SACU/ACU Licence holders must pay SACU/ACU Supplement of £10.

Entry details: Open on publication, close 30<sup>th</sup> April 2024 or when full. Fees: £100 for two days or £50 per day plus appropriate licence fee (payable by Bank Transfer or cheque). Cheques must be payable to Galloway Motorcycle Club Ltd. To be sent to the secretary of the meeting. Bank transfers or cheques must be paid by January 31<sup>st</sup>. Please enter 'Cumstone' plus riders name as reference on Bank Transfers. Galloway Motorcycle Club Ltd, The Royal Bank of Scotland, Sort Code 83-18-06, Account No 15084258.

Refund policy: If you enter the meeting and then have a valid reason why you won't be able to attend and would like a refund of your entry fee, you must contact the secretary of the meeting before April 28th. Refunds after this date can only be made for exceptional circumstances decided at the discretion of the Board. All cancellations will incur a £10 administration charge.

**Insurance:** The SACU has arranged **Public Liability Insurance**. Insured with **Convex Ltd** and **Personal Accident Insurance** insured with **Aviva**, for protection of their clubs, officials, and licence holders, for events which are run under a SACU permit or certificate of exemption of permit.

Machines: In good working order and race worthy, as per stated class and passed by the club's technical officers, all machines must be fitted with an engine cut out button.

Scrutineering: All bikes, Helmets and Body armour must be scrutineered and passed by the club's technical officers. Scrutineer's decision is final.

Clothing: All riders must wear Helmet (with current ACU stamp) – Gloves – Knee length protective boots – Goggles (non splinterable) (Tear-offs are strictly banned) – SACU/ACU approved body armour. Spectacles if worn must be non-splinterable. Helmet and body cameras are strictly prohibited.

Environment: power washing is prohibited – use bins/skips provided for all your rubbish. Dumping of oil is strictly prohibited and will incur a penalty of instant dismissal from the event. Tear offs are strictly prohibited and will incur a penalty of instant dismissal from the event.

**Transponders:** Transponders will be used at this event, all transponders must be **MY LAPS** compatible, Transponders will be available to hire at a cost of £15 for the duration of the event, damaged or lost transponders will incur a charge at the discretion of the hire provider.

Flag signals: As per SACU/ACU guidelines. Please take note of the following rule change regarding flag signals:

Waved yellow: Great danger, be prepared to stop, no overtaking, a significant reduction in speed must be seen, jumps should not be attempted.

Fire safety: All riders MUST carry a 2kg dry powder fire extinguisher.

Concussion: All riders MUST notify the club of any recent (within the last 23 days) concussion injury and will produce a doctor's note to state they are able to compete in the event, the doctors note must state (The rider is no longer suffering the consequences of concussion).

Riding in the paddock: riders must travel at walking pace at all times and stay on the designated roadways.

Illegal Riding: Anyone found riding on the track out with races or misbehaving in the paddock will be disqualified from the event.

Animals: All animals must be kept on a leash at all times.

## **Classes:**

Pre-68; Bikes manufactured before 31st December 1967 - Up to 250cc + Over 250cc (race together, scored separately)

Pre-75; Bikes manufactured before 31st December 1974 - Up to 250cc + Over 250cc (race together, scored separately)

Pre-78; Bikes manufactured before 31st December 1977 - Up to 250cc + Over 250cc (race together, scored separately)

Twinshock or Pre-84 Air cooled & Drum brakes; Bikes manufactured from 1st January 1978 to 31st December 1983.

# **SACU Privacy Policy**

The SACU is the recognised licencing Authority for Motorcycle Sport in Scotland. We collect date from members for the purpose of issuing race licences, official's licences, race start permissions and insurance. Details are stored on a computer system to allow the production of licences and record results where required for licence conditions (Road Race and Trials). This information is stored securely and accurately. Personal details are only used for contacting members re licencing matters, notification of awards and investigation of medical matters. Clubs may be provided with a member's name and licence number to prove they hold a licence for competition. Clubs provide a list of members annually - these are stored in paper format and only used to confirm numerical accuracy of membership submissions. Payment details submitted are used to take payment and then immediately destroyed. No payment details are recorded. We may disclose your personal information to the extent that we are required to do so by law in connection with any legal proceedings or prospective legal proceedings. This will include the reporting of personal accident details for insurance purposes Except as provided in this privacy policy, we will not provide your information to third parties. Members have the right to request a copy of the data recorded about them for accuracy. Please let us know if your information needs to be corrected. Members may submit a complaint to the Information Commissioners Office if their information is inaccurate or used inappropriately.
